Accommodations		<i>Note: We provide linens, pillows, and towels for the 4 Hale only.</i>
Hale 'Ohana	This historic home was the original home on site built in the 1930s. This two-story house has 4 bedrooms, 1.5 bathrooms, a fully equipped kitchen, and a living room with a rustic fireplace. Hale 'Ohana comfortably sleeps 11-14 people with one queen bed and five bunk beds.	\$300/night + tax
Hale Kokua	This Hale, originally built in the 1940s, is located above the Camp Office. It features 2 bedrooms, 1 bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen, a living space as well as a small outdoor deck. Hale Kokua comfortably sleeps 3-4 people with one queen bed and two twin beds.	\$250/night + tax
Hale Makali'i	This house has one large open floor plan featuring 1 bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen and a large outdoor covered lanai space, perfect for overlooking the camp's scenic views. Hale Makali'i comfortably sleeps 6-8 people with two queen beds, two twin beds, and one bunk bed.	\$200/night + tax
Hale Mahaholokai	Located near the summit of Mauna Kapu (15 min from Camp) this cabin offers commanding views of West Oahu at your door step. Mahaholokai features 1 bedroom, 1 bathroom, a fully equipped kitchen, a large living/dining area, a fireplace, and a large lanai and lawn area. This cabin comfortably sleeps 5-8 people with one queen bed, one queen futon, one bunk bed, and two twin futons.	\$350/night + tax
Mauka Bunkhouses	We have 4 bunkhouses on site, each sleeping 16. Toilets and showers are detached in a nearby building. <i>*Linens are not provided</i>	\$25/per person/night + tax
Paniolo Bunkhouse	This is the largest bunkhouse on site, sleeping 48 total. The building has 12 rooms, each accommodating 4 people. Showers and toilets are attached. <i>*Linens are not provided</i>	\$25/per person/night + tax
Tent Camping	Bring your own tent for a rustic camping experience in the mountains. We have a small camping field for groups with less than 10 people, and a large field for groups with more than 10. Showers and toilet facility included.	\$50/night + tax for less than 5 people \$15/per person/night + tax for groups of more than 5 people

Meals	Enjoy hot and ready camp favorites made from scratch, served buffet style. Ask us for a menu!	Breakfast: \$10+ tax Lunch: \$10 + tax Dinner: \$10 + tax
Halawai Conference Room	This is a great indoor space for a retreat or meeting in the mountains. Choose a time session for exclusive use of the space. The room comes with tables and chairs to seat 60, a projector, and a screen.	\$175 + tax/day
Mess Hall and Commercial Kitchen	Use our mess hall for extra meeting/activity session space in between meal times. It features dining hall seating for approx. 80 people and includes exclusive use of the attached fully-certified commercial kitchen with cooking equipment, an ice machine, and eating utensils included.	\$175 + tax/day
Pavilion	This is a covered space on an elevated concrete slab with picnic tables, located right above our camp pool. It seats approx. 60 people and includes use of two Hibachi grills.	\$125 + tax/day
Swimming Pool	Our camp pool is 50ft x 25ft going from 3 ft to 9 ft deep, with a deck, basketball hoop, pool noodles and deckchairs. *Must provide own certified lifeguard or pay an extra fee for camp to provide one.	\$100 + tax/1 hour \$50 + tax/each additional hour Lifeguard: \$25 + tax/hour
Makahiki Field	Rent our large tent camping field exclusively for your own activities or event! Please inquire with the office for availability.	\$200 + tax/day *Rate may vary depending on event type
Fire Circle – <i>Lua Ahi</i>	We have a large fire pit that can seat approx. 50 people, amphitheater style. We provide kindling and wood, just bring your favorite s'mores ingredients!	\$75 + tax/day Free with accommodations
Basketball Court	We have a regular sized court with basketballs included. Please inquire with the office for reservations.	Free

Guided Tours:		
<p>Guided Hikes: -Nānākuli Overlook -WWII Bunkers -Mauna Kapu -Palikea Ridge Line</p>	<p>Camp Pālehua only allows hiking access via our guided hikes with camp staff. The Nānākuli Overlook hike is about 2 miles roundtrip, approx. 2 hours total, featuring views and mo'olelo of Nānākuli Valley. The WWII Bunker hike is about 4 miles roundtrip, approx. 3 hours total, and takes hikers on top of an old bunker overlooking Diamond Head all the way around to Makaha. Please inquire with the office for more details on the Mauna Kapu and Palikea Ridge Line hikes.</p>	<p>Nānākuli Overlook: \$10/per person + tax</p> <p>*Educational groups receive a discounted rate of \$5/student + tax</p> <p>WWII Bunkers: \$15/per person + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of 10 people in group required. Smaller groups must pay the 10 person minimum group rate.</p>
<p>Pā Archeological Site</p>	<p>The Pā is an ancient Native Hawaiian archaeological site and place of learning. Camp staff guides this 2 hour tour. Please inquire with the office for availability.</p>	<p>\$5/per person + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of 25 people in group required</p>

<p>Low Ropes Course</p>	<p>Our low ropes obstacle course offers 2 hours of teamwork, communication, leadership, and problem-solving activities grounded in Hawaiian focus-values facilitated by our camp staff.</p>	<p>\$15/per person + tax</p> <p>*Educational groups receive a discounted rate of \$10/student + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of 10 people in group required</p>

<p>Massage Therapy</p>	<p>Take your Pālehua experience to the next level with a rejuvenating custom massage using a variety of deep tissue and/or Swedish techniques. <p>Native Plant Scavenger Hunt</p>	<p>Practice your plant identification skills by going on a hunt for a variety of Native Hawaiian plant species within the Camp grounds. Take a tour afterwards through our Native Hawaiian plant gardens to check your scavenger hunt worksheets and learn more about the identified plants.</p>	<p>\$5/per person + tax</p>
<p>Plant Propagation</p>	<p>Learn about the role and propagation process of native plants, especially that of the ma'o (Hawaiian cotton) plant and have the opportunity to collect and grow ma'o seeds to take home. <i>*Led together with Mālama Learning Center Staff</i></p>	<p>\$15/per person + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of \$250 payment per group. Plant A Native	This activity allows campers to figuratively and literally plant a native by grounding themselves in culture and outplanting a Native Hawaiian plant in our Camp garden. Plants are propagated on site by our partner Mālama Learning Center. <i>*Led together with Mālama Learning Center Staff</i>	<p>\$10/per person + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of \$250 payment per group. Maximum of 40 participants.</p> <p>*Based on plant availability. Call Camp Office to inquire.</p>
Art:		
Sustainable Art	Great for younger groups, this activity allows campers to engage in a variety of art activities blending conservation with culture. Participants will learn how dyes are used in Hawaiian culture and will get a chance to make one or two natural dyes out of plants (i.e. 'olena, ma'o, kukui, Christmas berry, etc.) to create art. Participants may also be using recycled t-shirts to create t-shirt bags or plant hangers while building a greater understanding of the importance of reusing materials whenever possible. <i>*Led together with Mālama Learning Center Staff</i>	<p>\$15/per person + tax</p> <p>*Minimum of \$250 payment per group. Maximum of 40 participants.</p> <p>*For youth groups with grades Pre-K through 3rd, we require a minimum chaperone to student ratio of 1 to 5.</p>
Movie Night	Experience an outdoor movie night under the stars on our Makahiki Field. Our camp staff will set up a 20ft inflatable movie screen equipped with movie style speakers and a projector with computer cord hookups. Groups will have to provide their own laptop with an already downloaded movie to play. <i>*Note: Please be sure to download the SD version of your movie of choice.</i>	\$300 + tax
